There are several ways you can help with the immediate needs. We have a fund established to accept donations that will be used to purchase relief and recovery supplies that will be given directly to churches on the front-line of relief efforts. We will be purchasing supplies for **Cleaning Buckets** and **Health Kits** to be assembled at our church or you can put together your own by following the instructions on the links below. Donations for this purpose will be greatly appreciated. The cost of one Cleaning Bucket averages \$75. The cost of a Health Kit averages \$12.
