The following guidelines are offered as a way for us to return to in-person worship and gatherings.

These guidelines are subject to change as the situation unfolds.

WORSHIP

We have resumed in-person worship using recommended guidelines.

- Masks, hand sanitizing and social distancing required.
- Worship spaces set up to allow 75% capacity.
- Will continue to offer online worship services via live stream of in-person services
- Nursery childcare will be available

RATIONALE

COVID-19 numbers are such that both government and health officials have relaxed restrictions. While we remain vigilant and are taking precautions, it’s time to begin returning to our life together.

SUNDAY SCHOOL

Sunday School for all ages will resume on campus as long as classes adhere to guidelines.

RATIONALE

Using the guidelines of Phase 3, which include masks, temperature checks, social distancing, and 75% capacity, we are allowing classes for all ages to resume. Online RSVP is required so we know how many will attend and can make room assignments according to the size of the class.

Classes can still meet online or utilize settings where social distancing and safety protocols can be adhered to.

SMALL GROUPS & CLASSES

Small groups and classes will resume on campus as long as they adhere to guidelines.

- If a group wants to meet at the church during the week they must contact the church office to reserve a room.
- Masks, hand sanitizing, temperature checks and social distancing required.
- Groups can also meet online, off-site, and outdoors where social distancing can be maintained.

RATIONALE

Adult groups can meet during the week in larger spaces to allow for guidelines to be met.

CHURCH OFFICE

The church office and facility will be open M-W-F 9–1 and by appointment.

- Masks, hand sanitizing and social distancing required.
- Employees who are able will continue to work from home.
- Employees who continue to work on site will adhere to proper social distancing and sanitation guidelines.

RATIONALE

Until a new Church Secretary is hired, the office will be open on limited schedule. All other staff will resume their normal activities.
